



QUOIN GALLERY SHEET



Quoins or cornerstones are used on traditional buildings to articulate the corners with strong shadow patterns. They were originally introduced in the 18th century to bring the colour and texture of stone to a masonry or brick structure, and they fill that purpose today. There are two standard sizes of quoins, three brick and four brick, see our drawing sheet for full particulars. Our thin section applied quoins can be fixed using an approved builder's epoxy adhesive; mechanical pin fixing as an additional safeguard is recommended. See our installation notes for full details.
